

The University Scholars Program in Medicine at Washington University in St. Louis provides a select group of talented first-year undergraduate students with admission both to the undergraduate program and to medical school.

Each student admitted to the program receives pre-professional advising throughout the undergraduate years and participates in the life of Washington University's School of Medicine. Students need to continue to meet the requirements and standards for medical school. University Scholars' interests and curiosity, as well as their academic and extracurricular accomplishments, add greatly to the life of the university.

Eligibility: High school seniors with outstanding academic records and extracurricular contributions to their school and community are encouraged to apply to the University Scholars Program. An admissions committee selects candidates to be presented to representatives from the School of Medicine. Finalists will be required to come to campus for interviews and related activities during finalists' weekend the spring of their senior year. Washington University will pay for finalists' round-trip expenses within the United States and their expenses while in St. Louis.

Application Requirements: To apply for the University Scholars Program, submit the following:

1. An application for admission to the Class of 2016 to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.
2. This separate *Application for University Scholars Program in Medicine*, which includes an essay.
3. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or from a research/volunteer supervisor. (See the recommendation form in this application.) This letter may be the same as the one submitted with your application for admission; if it is the same, however, you must send a copy with your University Scholars Program application.

University Scholars Program CHECKLIST

- 1. Submit an application for admission to the Class of 2016.
- 2. Also complete this *Application for University Scholars Program in Medicine*, including your essay.
- 3. Provide a letter of recommendation.
- 4. Make a copy of all your forms to keep for your files.

The University Scholars Program application is due to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions by **January 15**.

Students who apply are encouraged to apply for financial assistance, if needed. (The University Scholars Program is an academic opportunity, **not** a scholarship program.) You may also apply for the academic scholarships and fellowships described in our *Scholarships* brochure for undergraduates, which is sent to high school students the summer before their senior year of high school. The deadline for applying for academic scholarships and fellowships is also January 15.
