

University Scholars Program in Medicine

Dual admission to Washington University as an undergraduate student and a medical student

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- Complete the pre-medical curriculum, along with any desired major/minor combination, while knowing a spot is reserved at the Washington University School of Medicine.
- Matriculate to the School of Medicine upon successful completion of your undergraduate studies. You will need to maintain and overall minimum 3.8 grade point average and achieve a minimum total score on the Medical College Admission Test at or above the 97th percentile.
- Receive guidance from a mentor in the School of Medicine as an undergraduate.
- Receive invitations to special lectures and other events held by the School of Medicine.
- Engage in groundbreaking research as an undergraduate, if interested. You will have the opportunity to work with professors and peers in a wide variety of laboratory settings, including labs at the School of Medicine.
- Receive personal pre-professional advising.
- Have opportunities to “shadow” a medical student or physician.

TO PARTICIPATE:

- ❑ Submit an application for admission to the Washington University Class of 2023 no later than January 2, 2019.
- ❑ Complete the Application for University Scholars Program in Medicine no later than January 2, 2019. All application materials and forms are available on the WashU Pathway, which will be active one to two days after you submit your application for admission.
- ❑ Finalists will need to come to campus for interviews and related activities the weekend of March 28–30. WashU will pay for finalists’ round-trip expenses within the United States, as well as their expenses while in St. Louis.

We look for students with compassion, commitment to community, aptitude, integrity, and motivation suitable for a career in medicine; with outstanding academic records; and with demonstrated leadership skills in their high school’s academic and extracurricular activities. If you change your mind and decide not to attend medical school, you still have many great choices for an outstanding education.
